Purpose

As a condition of participating in the tuition assistance program that is available to eligible U.S. service members who attend Western Nebraska Community College, the College is required to enter into a memorandum of understanding with the United States Department of Defense, Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness, which requires the adoption of a policy banning inducements for securing the enrollment of service members in the College.

Scope

All current or potential WNCC students who are active or have veteran status in a branch of U.S. service.

Policy

Pursuant to the above memorandum of understanding requirement, the Board does hereby ban inducements (including any gratuity, favor, discount, entertainment, hospitality, loan, transportation, lodging, meals, or other item having a monetary value of more than a de minimus amount) to any individual or entity (other than salaries paid to the College's employees or fees paid to contractors of the College in conformity with all applicable laws) for the purpose of securing enrollments of military service members or obtaining access to tuition assistance funds (TA funds).

Revising this Policy

This Board Policy supersedes any prior WNCC policy, procedure, guideline or handbook on this subject matter.
