

**Question 48: Are you currently serving on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces for purposes other than training?**

**Members of the U.S. Armed Forces:**

- Answer “Yes” if you are engaged in active duty and you are in the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard.

**Members of the National Guard or Reserves:**

- Answer “Yes” if you are on active duty for other than state or training purposes.
- Answer “No” if you are on active duty only for state or training purposes.

*If you answer “Yes” to Question 48, Western Nebraska Community College will require you to submit a copy of your DD214 Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty **or** a letter from your superior officer documenting the call-up to active duty and which indicates the character of service was anything but dishonorable. Federal financial aid will **not** be administered until we receive the required documentation.*

**Question 49: Are you a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces?**

**Members of the U.S. Armed Forces:**

- Answer “Yes” if you have engaged in active duty as a member of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, or Coast Guard **and** you were released under a condition other than dishonorable.
- Answer “Yes” if you are not a veteran now but will be one by June 30, of applicable award year.
- Answer “No” if you are currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces and will continue to serve through June 30, of applicable award year.

**Members of the National Guard or Reserves:**

- Answer “Yes” if you were on active duty for other than state or training purposes.
- Answer “No” if you were an enlistee only for state or training purposes.

*If you answer “Yes” to Question 49, the Central Processing System performs a match with the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to confirm that status. Depending upon the match status received from VA, Western Nebraska Community College may require you to submit a copy of your DD214 Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty. Federal financial aid will **not** be administered until we receive the required documentation.*
