Historic Perspective (2014 to present)

Ms. Klemke, past Board chairperson shared information regarding past issues with HLC and accreditation and how the Board stepped up to take a more active role in accreditation and implementation of policies. Additional discussion included the Covid period, past Capital Campaign and renovation of the main campus, shared governance work, implementation of a new strategic plan, presidential searches and past consultants and their purpose.

Discussion of Proposed 2024-2025 WCCA Budgets

Ms. Koski, Vice President of Administrative Services reviewed the 2024-2025 Preliminary Capital Improvement Fund Budget. A breakdown of external/internal expenditures was provided. Total budget expenditures for 2023-24 were \$19,123,617 and 2024-25 is currently at \$16,372,801.

Discussion of 2024 Budget and Special Tax Hearing Timeline for FY25

Ms. Koski reviewed the timeline for preparation and presentation of budget information along with specific submission deadlines.
