#### 2. Adoption of Resolution Setting the Property Tax Request

**WHEREAS**, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1632 provides that the Governing Body of Western Nebraska Community College passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

**WHEREAS**, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Governing Body of Western Nebraska Community College resolves that the **2024-2025 property tax request be set at:** 

General Fund

Bond Fund - \$3,384,844.31

Total Tax Request: \$3,384,844.31

The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 7.9 percent.

The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property would be 0.09167 per \$100 of assessed value.

Western Nebraska Community College proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be 0.021121 per \$100 of assessed value.

Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of Western Nebraska Community College will increase (or decrease) last year's budget by 1.25 percent.
