PLANNING AHEAD IS KEY

It increases your chances of SUCCESS!

The sooner you determine what your educational goals are and where you plan to fulfill those goals, the more likely you are to experience a smooth transition. Establishing a clear pathway will increase your likelihood of success! Let's get started...

DO SOME RESEARCH

- Find out what colleges offer the programs in which you are interested:
 - Search Nebraska colleges and universities.
 - Search Colorado colleges and universities.
 - Research the **University of Wyoming**.
 - Search South Dakota colleges and universities.
 - **TIDBIT**: Interested in looking at other states? A simple Google search on "higher education in [insert state]" will get you the information you need.
- Find out what scholarship opportunities are available and learn about the deadlines for submission.
- Research the admission processes for the colleges and programs in which you are interested.
- Research the communities in which the colleges are located (think about size, things to do, cost of living, etc.).

MAKE AN APPOINTMENT

- Establishing contact with the schools in which you are interested.
- Learning about the process for requesting and sending transcripts.
- Starting the process of determining how your WNCC credits will transfer to your new college or university.

I KNOW WHERE I'M HEADED, NOW WHAT?

- Plan a visit to the college or university you have selected to make sure it is right for you.
- ✓ Apply for admission.
- ✓ Apply for scholarships and financial aid.
 - TIDBIT: Remember that you can start the FAFSA submission process on December. It's the same no matter what college or university you attend!
- Request that your WNCC (and any other) transcripts be sent and evaluated.
- Make direct contact with the department that houses the
 ✓ program you will be studying (e.g. Education, Criminal
 Justice, Business, etc.).
- ✓ Plan to attend transfer orientation if it is available!
