Guide to Transferring General Education Courses 2026-2027

Welcome to the WNCC dual-credit transfer guide. This guide is intended to help high school counselors, students, and parents understand how WNCC courses fit into the general studies programs at WNCC and regional colleges/universities. The surest way to ensure course transfer is for students to get their associate's degree from WNCC, as the entire degree will transfer to most institutions and replace the respective institution's general core classes. It is unusual for a degree to not be accepted by another college.

All courses listed in this guide are available to dual-credit students in the WNCC service area either live, virtual, or online. Other options may be available for students near a WNCC campus. If there are ever questions about the transferability of a WNCC course, please contact the CollegeNOW office, preferable before enrolling in a course.

How to use this guide:

- College/University names are listed in the blue heading—this indicates how the listed courses fit specifically into this respective school's general education curriculum
- The official title of each respective school's general studies curriculum is listed in parentheses under the school's name
- The number listed in yellow on the left side of each table indicates which general studies criteria is being met with the courses listed in the second column
