

Admission Criteria for the Associate Degree Nursing Program

Students may start applying to the associate degree nursing program in September the year prior to their admission into the nursing program. The full-time associate degree nursing program starts every fall in August and students will graduate in 4 semesters.

Applications must be received by May 15th the year students are applying for admission. Selection for admission is a competitive process.

Below are the requirements for admission:

Total Prerequisite Credit Hours	22 credit hours

Additional admission requirements

- 1. Prerequisite GPA of 3.0
- 2. Prerequisite courses must have a grade of C or higher
- 3. Completion of Entrance Exam (ATI Critical Thinking with a score of 60 or higher and ATI TEAS test with a score of Proficiency level of higher)
- 4. Science courses must have been taken within the last 10 years, excluding Introductory Chemistry
- 5. Proof of current (Active) certificate on registry as a basic nursing assistant
