



Admission Criteria for the Practical Nursing Program

Students may start applying to the Practical Nursing program in September the year prior to their admission into the nursing program. The full-time Practical Nursing program starts every fall in August and students will graduate in 2 semesters.

Applications must be received by May 15th the year students are applying for admission. Selection for admission is a competitive process.
